



rearrange: change the position of or order of something. (verb)






She rearranged the books so she could find certain ones more easily.

The man is deaf, so he **communicates** by sign language.





train: to teach a person or animal how to do something over a period of time. (verb)



He was able to train the dog to do tricks after a few weeks of practice.



Birds + +++

Many people decide to have birds as pets. Birds can make great pets for several reasons. Most can be kept in cages, so they are good pets if you live in the city and have an apartment. Birds are very intelligent and can be **trained** to do different tricks. Some birds can even be taught to speak and **communicate** with their owners! You don't have to take them for walks like a dog, but you do have to make sure to feed and water them properly. Birds can <u>rearrange</u> their feathers and clean themselves, but need water to do this. So, if you are looking for a pet that doesn't take a lot of work, you might want to choose a bird.
