museum: a building where people can go to see cool things (noun)






The children were excited to go to the museum and see dinosaurs.








The kids were happy to reach the museum safely. They spent the rest of the day looking at dinosaur skeletons, famous paintings, and other amazing things.






Simple Past Tense Verbs


Some past tense verbs don't follow the rules because you cannot add -ed. These verbs change to new words.






Phonics
