sidewalk: a place for people to walk on, often at the side of a street or road (noun)

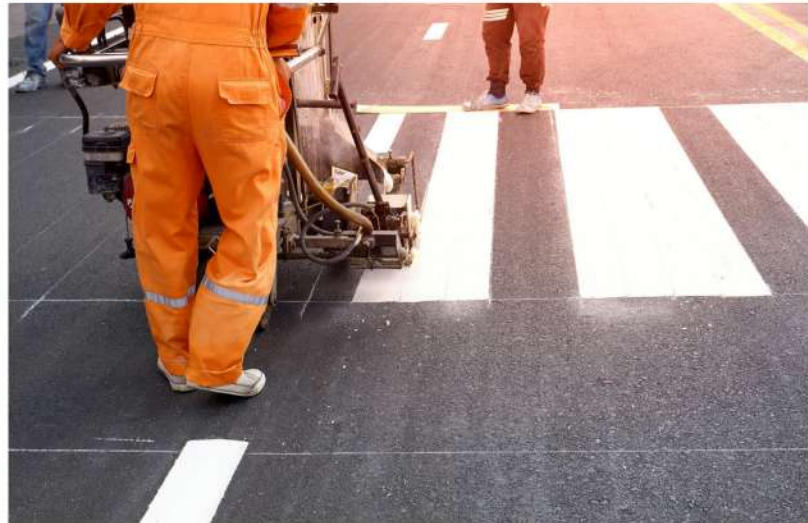


They walked on the **sidewalk** to stay safe.

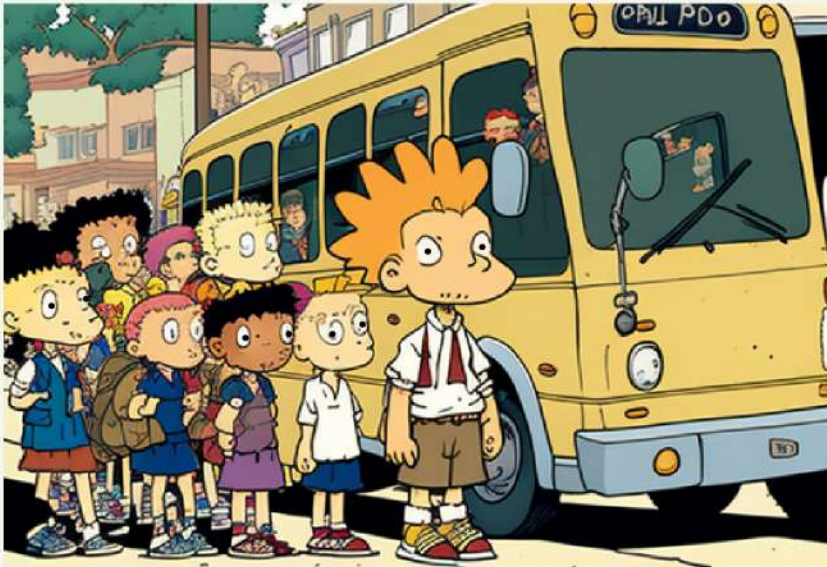


Field Trip

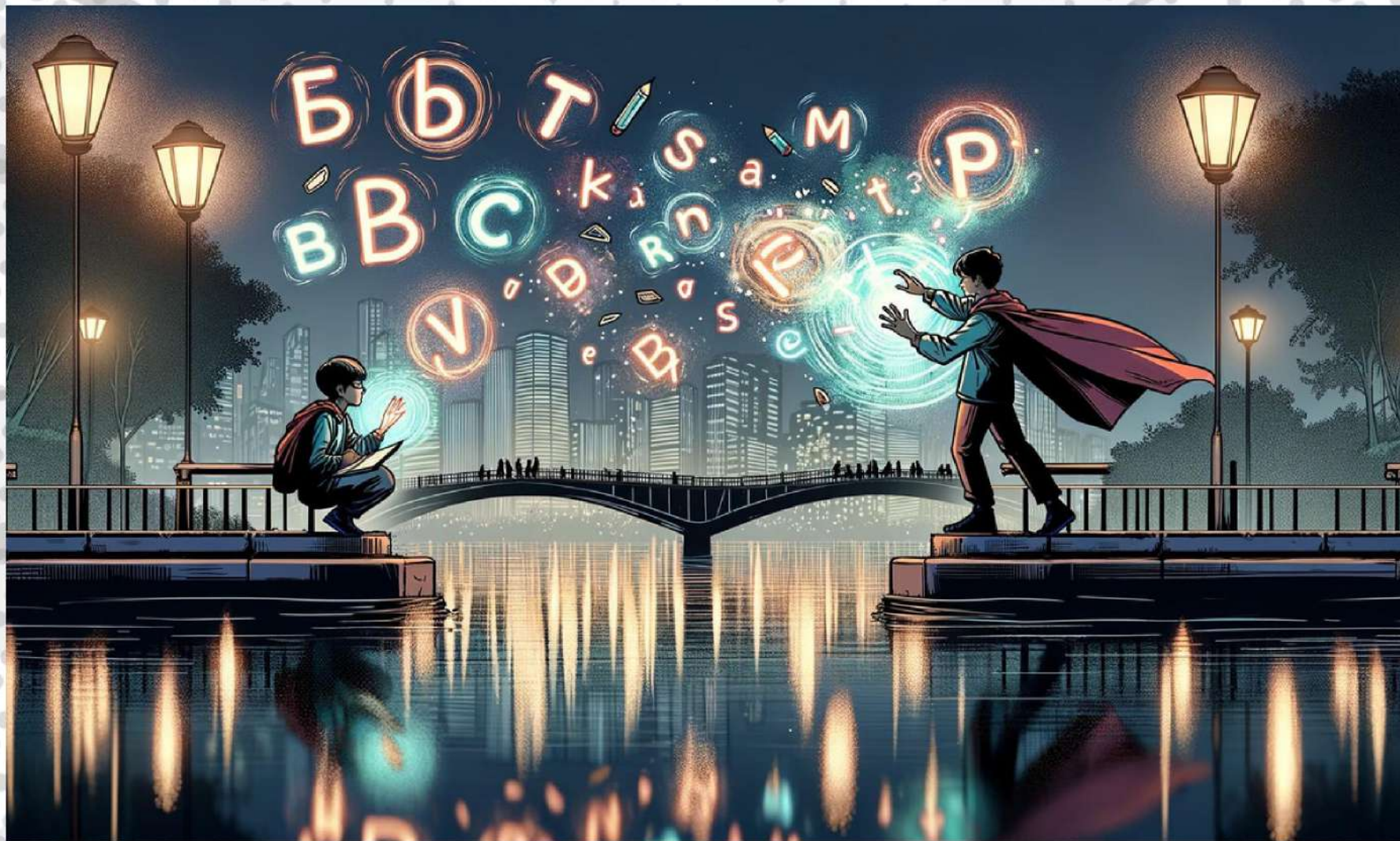


Simple Past Tense Verbs

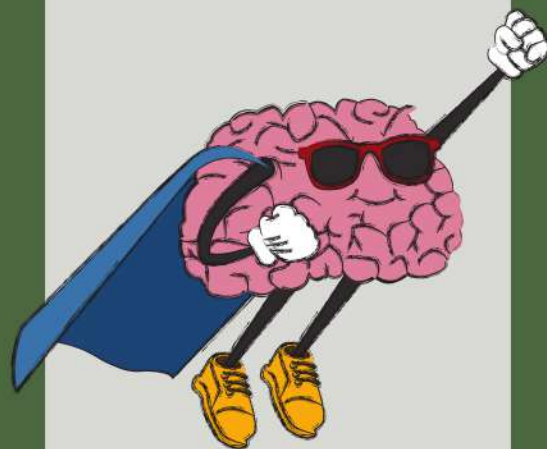
