elevator: a machine that carries people up and down a building; a lift (noun)



She took the **elevator** to the eighteenth floor.

cinema: a place where people pay to watch films (movies); a movie theater (noun)



They ate popcorn while watching a movie at the **cinema**.

Let's Go To The Mall



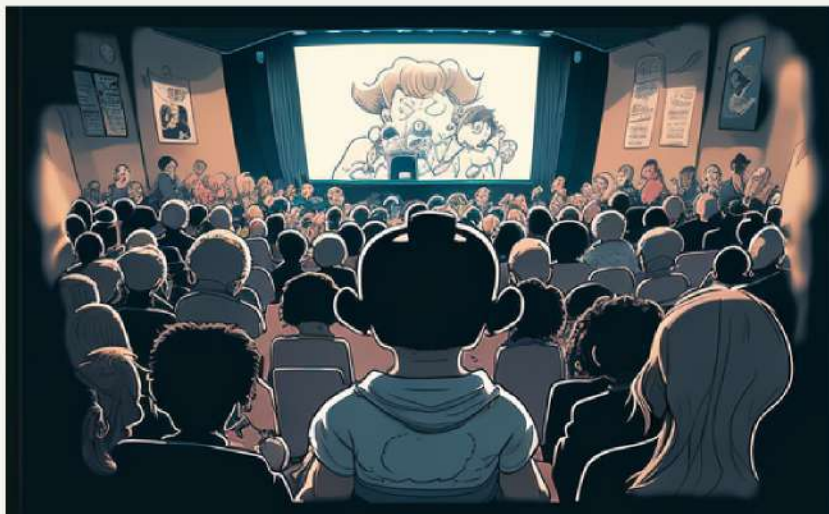

 give - gave
 find - found
 tell - told
 bring - brought
 feel - felt
 leave - left

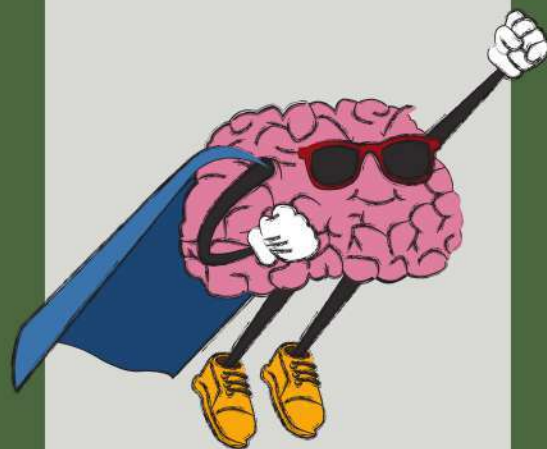
