






Vocabulary

food court: an area in the mall with many places to buy food with tables to sit and eat (noun)

elevator: a machine that carries people up and down a building; a lift (noun)





She took the elevator to the eighteenth floor.





cinema: a place where people pay to watch films (movies); a movie theater (noun)





They ate popcorn while watching a movie at the cinema.


