# Outdoors - Vocabulary



**mountain:** land that is much higher than the land around it (noun)



Snow covered the top of the **mountain**.

# Outdoors - Vocabulary



**trail:** a path through the countryside, mountain, or forest area (noun)



They hiked up the **trail** to the top of the mountain.



# Outdoors - Vocabulary



**river:** a long stream of water flowing toward the ocean or other body of water (noun)



The **river** flows very fast in the mountains.

**hike:** to walk through the countryside, mountain, or forest area (verb)



The boys really enjoy taking a long **hike** up the mountain.

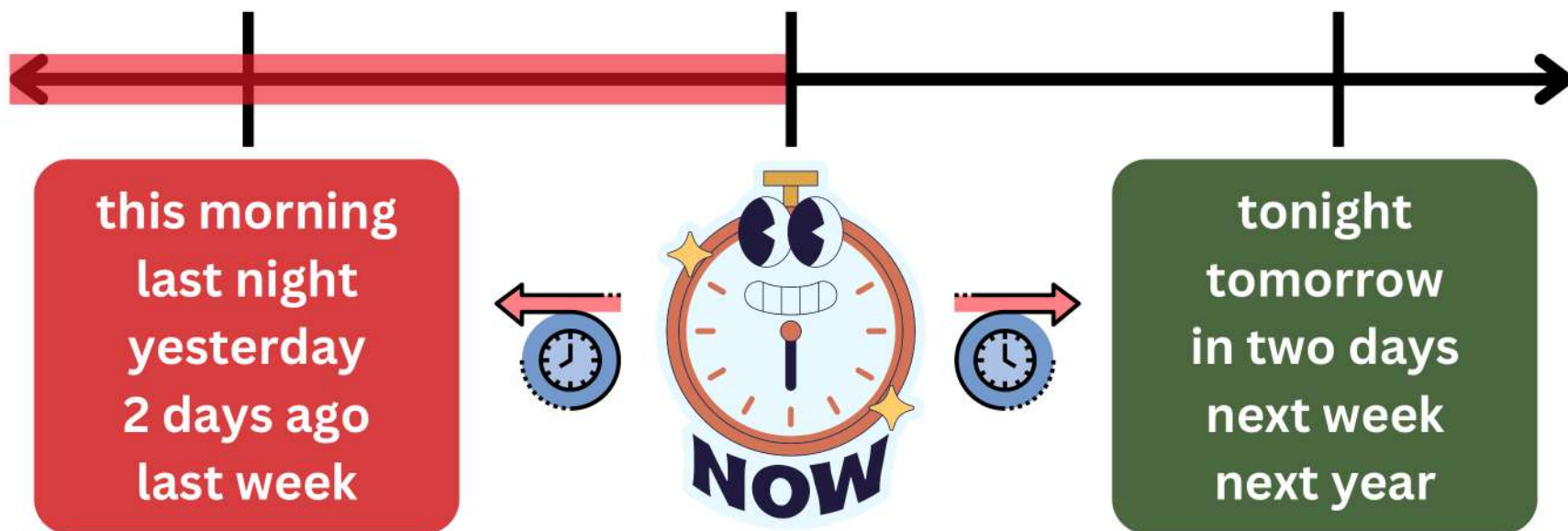


# Simple Past Tense Verbs

We use **past** simple for things that have already happened.

**past (before now)**

**future (after now)**





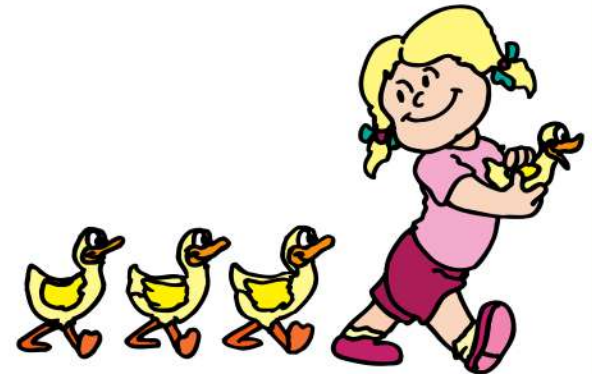
# Simple Past Tense Verbs

Verb ends in a vowel sound or a voiced consonant (l, n, r, b, g, m, z, v), then the **-ed** ending sounds like a **/d/**

called**ed**  
clean**ed**  
offer**ed**  
enjoy**ed**  
used**ed**  
grabb**ed**



lov**ed**



follow**ed**

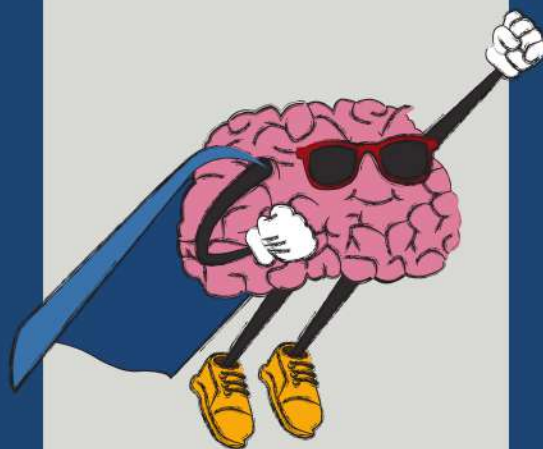




# Phonics
