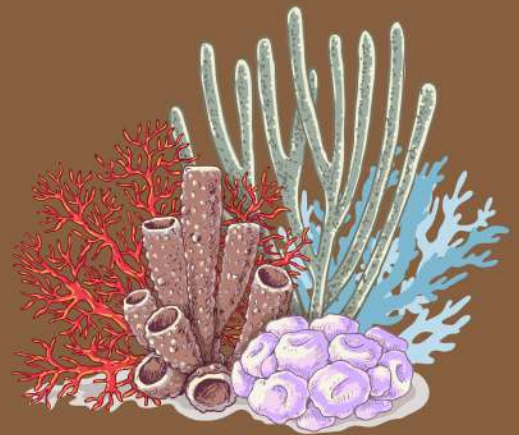

adventure: a fun and exciting activity or trip (noun)

Habitats - Vocabulary



leftovers: food that you didn't finish eating (noun)



She threw the **leftovers** in the trash.

enjoy: to have fun or feel happy doing something (verb)



The boy really **enjoyed** playing in the ocean with his dad.

hunt: to chase or search for a wild animal to kill it for food (verb)



The man was **hunting** birds with his dogs.

Habitats - The Ocean



Max, Sam, and Lila were three best friends who **enjoy** going on **adventures**. Today they took a submarine under the ocean. This underwater habitat was full of amazing plants and animals.

Habitats - The Ocean



First, they saw some clownfish hiding in a sea anemone (ah-neh-muh-nee). The sea anemone kept the clownfish safe, and the clownfish kept the sea anemone clean by eating its leftovers.

Next, they saw a sea turtle swimming with its strong flippers. The turtle's shell keeps it safe. Then, they saw a school of colorful fish with shiny scales.

Then they drove a little farther and saw a jellyfish with long, flowing tentacles (ten-tuh-kulz). After they passed the jellyfish, they came to an old shipwreck at the bottom of the ocean.
