







Vocabulary







fix: to make something that is broken able to work again (verb)

boss: the person at a job that tells the workers what to do (noun)





Mary is the boss, so she makes sure her workers are doing a good job.



tool: something that helps you build or fix things (noun)





Matt grabbed a tool from his toolbox.



customer: a person who buys goods or a service (noun)





The store clerk handed the bag to the customer after she paid.

Jack <u>fixes</u> cars. He is a mechanic. Jack owns a car repair shop in the city. Jack loves fixing cars and helping people get back on the road.







Every day, Jack wakes up early and opens his shop. Jack has five other mechanics that work for him. He is a good <u>boss</u>, so his workers like him a lot.







Jack and the other mechanics clean their <u>tools</u> and the shop to get ready for <u>customers</u> to arrive. Soon, cars will start driving into his shop to get fixed.









The mechanics listen to what is wrong with each car and then use their tools to fix them. They fix many problems like flat tires and motors that won't start.







Jack's customers are very happy when their cars are fixed. The mechanics love helping people. At the end of the day, Jack closes up his shop and goes home. Tomorrow he will do it all over again.


