






Vocabulary







leak: to let water or gas come out through a hole or crack (verb)





The pipe is **leaking** and water is going all over the floor.



pipe: a tube through which liquids or gases can flow (noun)





They have many different pipe sizes to choose from.



clog: to become blocked or filled so nothing can go through (verb)





Hair often clogs the bathtub, so the water can't drain.



drain: to remove liquid from something (verb)





Pull the sink plug so the water can drain out of it.

Let's Read!











Uh-oh! The sink <u>pipes</u> have a <u>leak</u>. Time to call Sam, the plumber! Sam owns a plumbing company. He is the boss. One of Sam's workers fixed the leak. Good as new!







Sam has many plumbers that work for him. What is a plumber? A plumber is someone who fixes water pipes. They mostly work in buildings, but some fix water pipes outside also.











Rebecca is sad. Her sink is <u>clogged</u>, and the water won't <u>drain</u>. She calls Sam, and he sends one of his plumbers to help her. The plumber uses his tools to find the clog and fix it.









These men are building a new house. They call Sam to put in the plumbing. Sam's plumbers put water pipes in the walls. They also put in all the new sinks, toilets, showers, and bathtubs.









Sam's plumbers also install appliances that need water. So, if you need a dishwasher, have a pipe that is leaking, or a sink that won't drain, call a plumber to come and fix your problem.


