# Jobs - Vocabulary



**tidy:** having everything put in the right place to look nice (adjective)



Her bedroom was very **tidy** and clean.

# Jobs - Vocabulary



**wipe:** to slide something over the surface of something else (verb)



He **wiped** the sweat off of his head with a small towel.



# Jobs - Vocabulary



**supply:** an amount of food and other things needed by people to use (noun)



The teacher has many art **supplies**.  
The woman has a **supply** of toilet paper.

**messy:** many things laying around and not in the right place; dirty and not tidy (adjective)

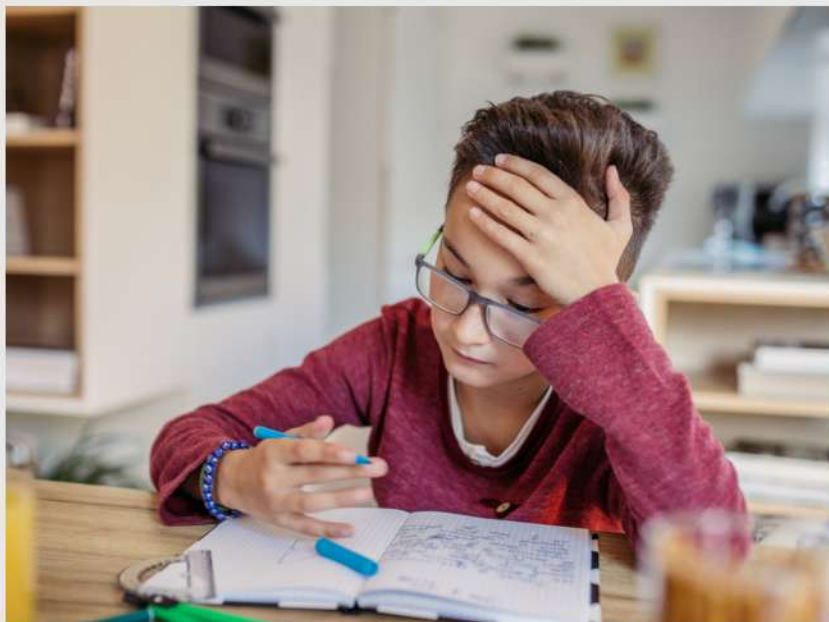

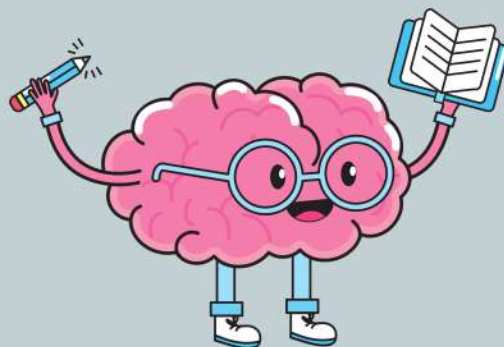


# Hard and Soft 'G'
