






# Vocabulary







temperature: how hot or cold something is, measured in degrees (noun)





The temperature is 42 degrees celsius on this hot summer day.



heat: a condition of being hot; hotness (noun)





The heat from the fire kept her hands warm.



shade: a darker area caused by something blocking the sun's light (noun)





The lion tried to lie in the shade to stay cool.



cool off: to become cool or cooler (phrasal verb)






The woman poured water on her face to **cool off** from the sun's heat.


