Seasons - Vocabulary



cancel: to stop something from happening (verb)

Seasons - Vocabulary



stack: to put things on top of each other (v); a pile of objects put on top of each other (n)



He ate a tall **stack** of pancakes for breakfast.

Seasons - Vocabulary



fort: a place or building that is built to use in a war or battle (noun)



The men stayed in the **fort** to stay safe from the enemy's guns.

warm up: to make the temperature of something go up (phrasal verb)



They **warmed up** their feet by the fire.

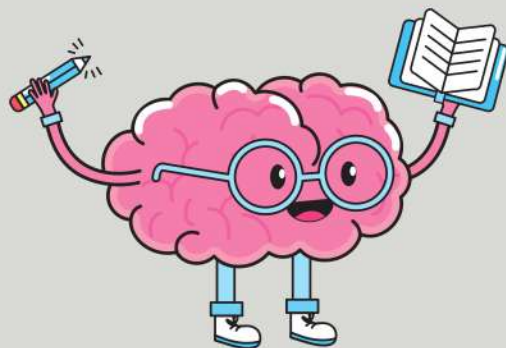
