uniform: a special set of clothes that people wear to show they are part of a group (noun)

casual (clothes): clothes worn every day for normal things, opposite of formal (adjective)

comfy (clothes): very comfortable clothes, often worn at home or to relax (adjective)





They put on comfy clothes, soft pajamas and warm socks, for the night.


Dress to Impress: Choosing the Right Outfit


