Fashion - Vocabulary



uniform: a special set of clothes that people wear to show they are part of a group (noun)



The kids wore their school uniforms, a blue shirt and black pants, every day to class.

Fashion - Vocabulary



formal (clothes): very nice clothes worn for special events or occasions (adjective)



Lucy felt grown-up in her **formal** clothes at her piano recital.

Fashion - Vocabulary



casual (clothes): clothes worn every day for normal things, opposite of formal (adjective)



Max wore his **casual** clothes, a T-shirt and shorts, to hang out with his friends.

Fashion - Vocabulary



comfy (clothes): very comfortable clothes, often worn at home or to relax (adjective)



They put on **comfy** clothes, soft pajamas and warm socks, for the night.

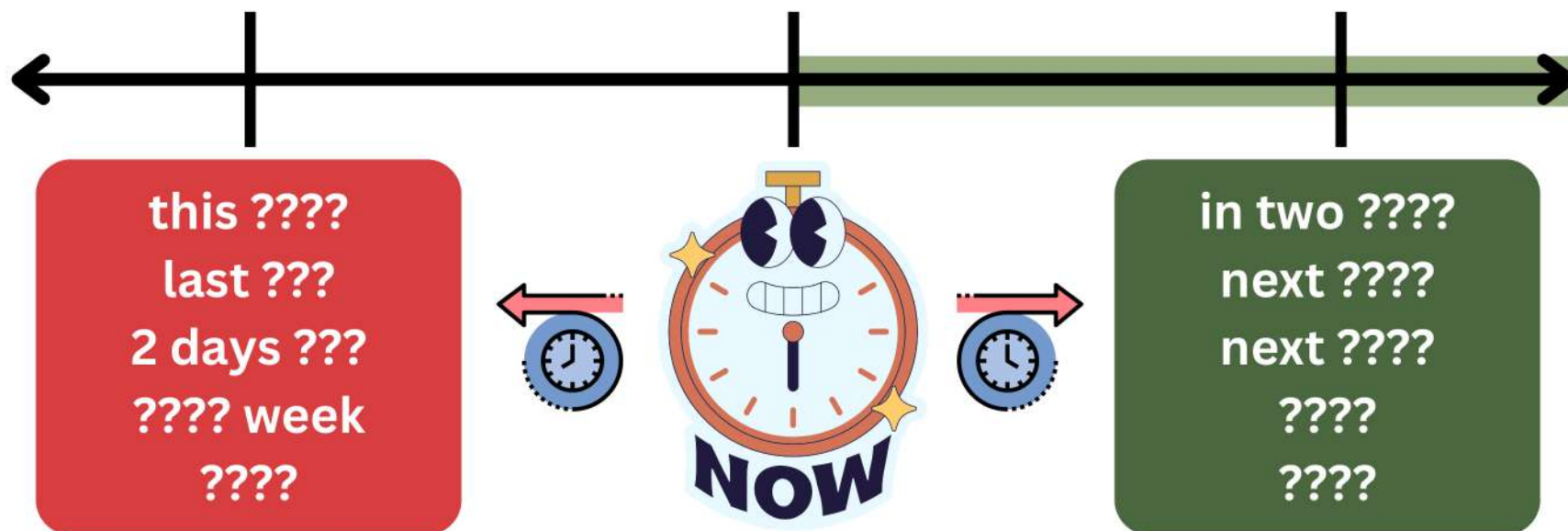


Future with Going To
