


This is Emma.

This is David.


This is his trash.

Adam and Tess are building a big sandcastle. Adam makes the walls, and Tess makes the towers. "This sandcastle is so big!" Tess says.






Jay and Nina are digging in the sand. "Let's find clams!" Jay says. They dig and dig. Soon, Nina finds one. "Look! A clam!" she says.


