






Vocabulary

board: to get on the airplane or any vehicle ready to take a trip (verb)





Before we could board the plane, we showed our boarding passes.



gate: the place in the airport where you wait and then get on the airplane (noun)





At the gate, we waited until it was time to board the plane.



Prepostitions of Movement


Around = to go in a circular type motion
