The First Six Months

There are twelve months in a year.

The first six months are:

January, February, March, April,
May, and June.



The First Six Months

January is the first month. It has 31 days. It is very cold. Sometimes it snows. People wear boots, coats, and gloves. Some people drink hot tea or soup to stay warm.



The First Six Months

February is the second month. It has 28 days, but every four years, it has 29 days. This is called a leap year. It is still winter. The days are short, and it is cold outside.
