surgery: a medical treatment in which someone's body is cut open so that a doctor can repair it (noun)





After the accident, she had **surgery** to fix her broken leg.



surgeon: a medical doctor who performs surgeries (noun)





The surgeon has to be very careful not to make a mistake during surgery.



numb: (of a part of the body) unable to feel anything (adjective)





His foot is **numb**, so he can't feel the doctor poking him with a needle.



stitches: threads used by doctors to close up wounds or cuts (noun)





The doctor used a needle and thread to give her stitches.

A Peek Inside the Operating Room





In a big hospital, there is a special room. This room is called the Operating Room, or OR for short. This is where doctors do <u>surgery</u>. Surgery is when doctors fix something inside the body.

A Peek Inside the Operating Room





The doctor who does the surgery is called a <u>surgeon</u>. The surgeon and nurses wear blue gowns, masks, hair caps, and gloves. These help to keep everything clean. Cleanliness is very important in the OR.

A Peek Inside the Operating Room





Before the surgery, the surgeon will make the patient's body part feel **numb**. This means the patient won't feel pain. The surgeon uses a special medicine for this. When something is numb, it feels sleepy or like it's not there.

A Peek Inside the Operating Room

Inside the OR, there are many tools. Some tools are small and sharp. The surgeon uses them to cut and fix the body. One important tool is the needle. The surgeon uses it to stitch. Stitching is like sewing. After the surgeon fixes the inside of the body, they use **stitches** to close the skin. Stitches help the skin heal. After some days, they can be removed.





A Peek Inside the Operating Room





The OR is a very busy place. Nurses help the surgeon. They give the tools to the surgeon. They watch the patient and make sure everything is okay.

A Peek Inside the Operating Room

When the surgery is done, the patient is taken to another room, called the recovery room, to wake up and rest. The OR is cleaned and made ready for the next patient.


So, the next time you hear someone say they need to "operate," you know they mean doing surgery in the OR. Remember, surgeons, stitches, and the OR are all part of the process to make people feel better.
