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Where **did** you **run** to yesterday?

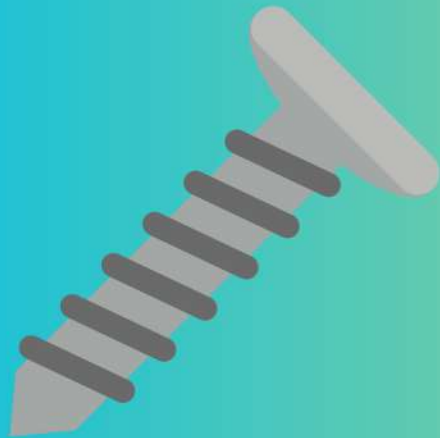
I **ran** to my friend's house yesterday.
