She uses a watering can to water her flowers.





The Vegetable Garden

The Vegetable Garden

Anna brings a small bag of seeds.
"This bag is tied so tight," she says.
She pulls hard and opens it. Inside
are seeds for carrots, tomatoes, and
lettuce.



The Vegetable Garden

They make little rows in the dirt. In each row, they make a small hole with their finger.

"Let's put one seed in each hole," says Leo.

They drop the seeds in the holes and bury them with soft dirt.
