explore: to travel through an area to learn about it or to search for something in it (verb)






We **explored** the city on our bikes during our vacation.



During the ferry ride, Max saw seagulls soaring and fish leaping from the water. "Hey fish, are you racing us to the island?" he called out, laughing at his own joke.






After a fun-filled day, it was time to return. As the ferry departed, Max waved at the island, saying, "Goodbye, Max Island. We'll be back for more adventures."
