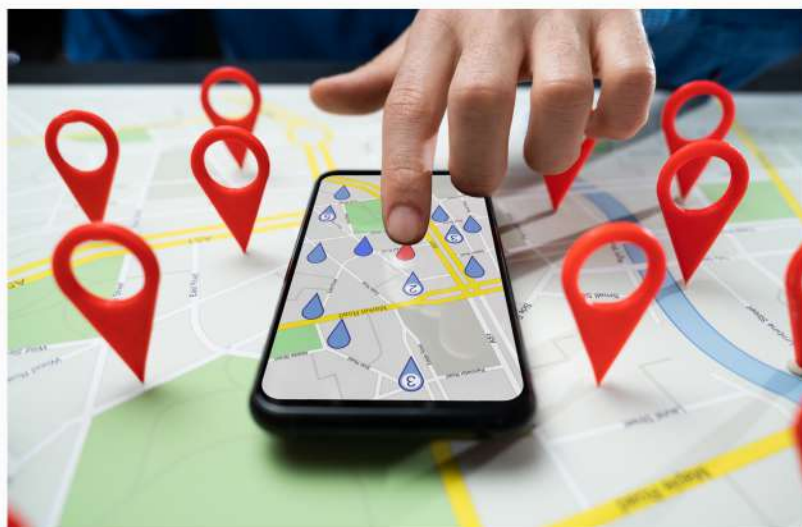
Vocabulary



Hanging Out - Vocabulary



local: located in the area that you live and not far away (adjective)



He searched for a **local** market on his phone.

Hanging Out - Vocabulary



float: to stay above a liquid and not sink (verb); a device used to stay above a liquid (noun)



They used their **floats** in the swimming pool.

Hanging Out - Vocabulary



goggles: special glasses that fit close to the face to protect the eyes, esp. used for swimming (noun)



She put on her **goggles** before swimming in the pool.

Hanging Out - Vocabulary



shallow: of little depth; not deep; esp. when talking about water (adjective)



The flamingos searched for fish in the **shallow** water.

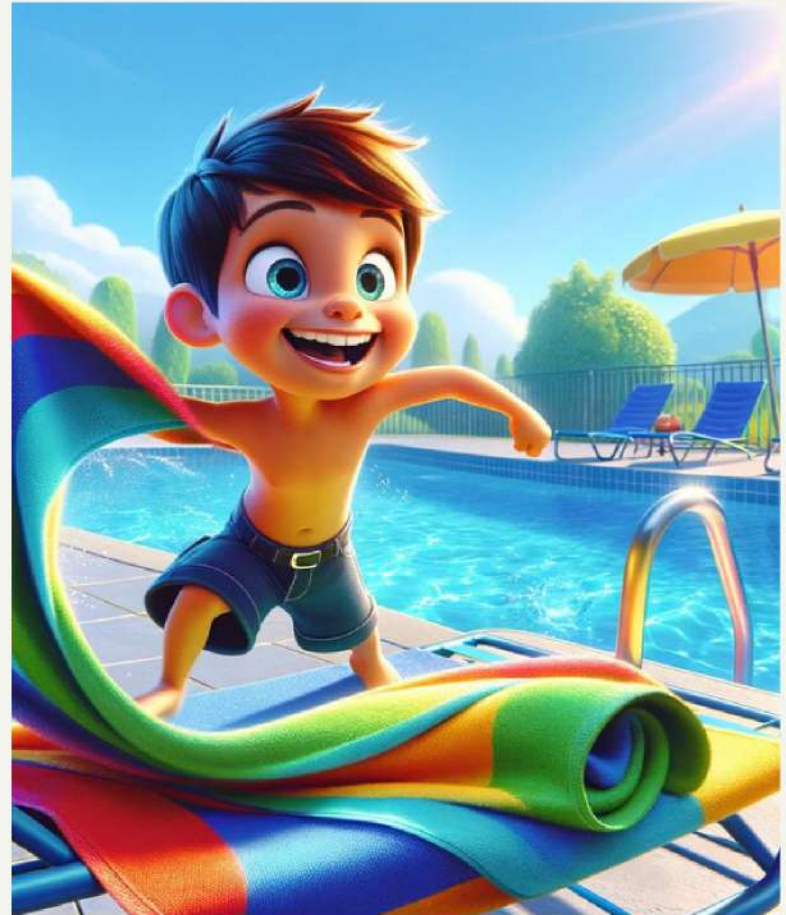

Max stayed by the edge, practicing his swimming. He liked to take it slow and enjoy the cool water.

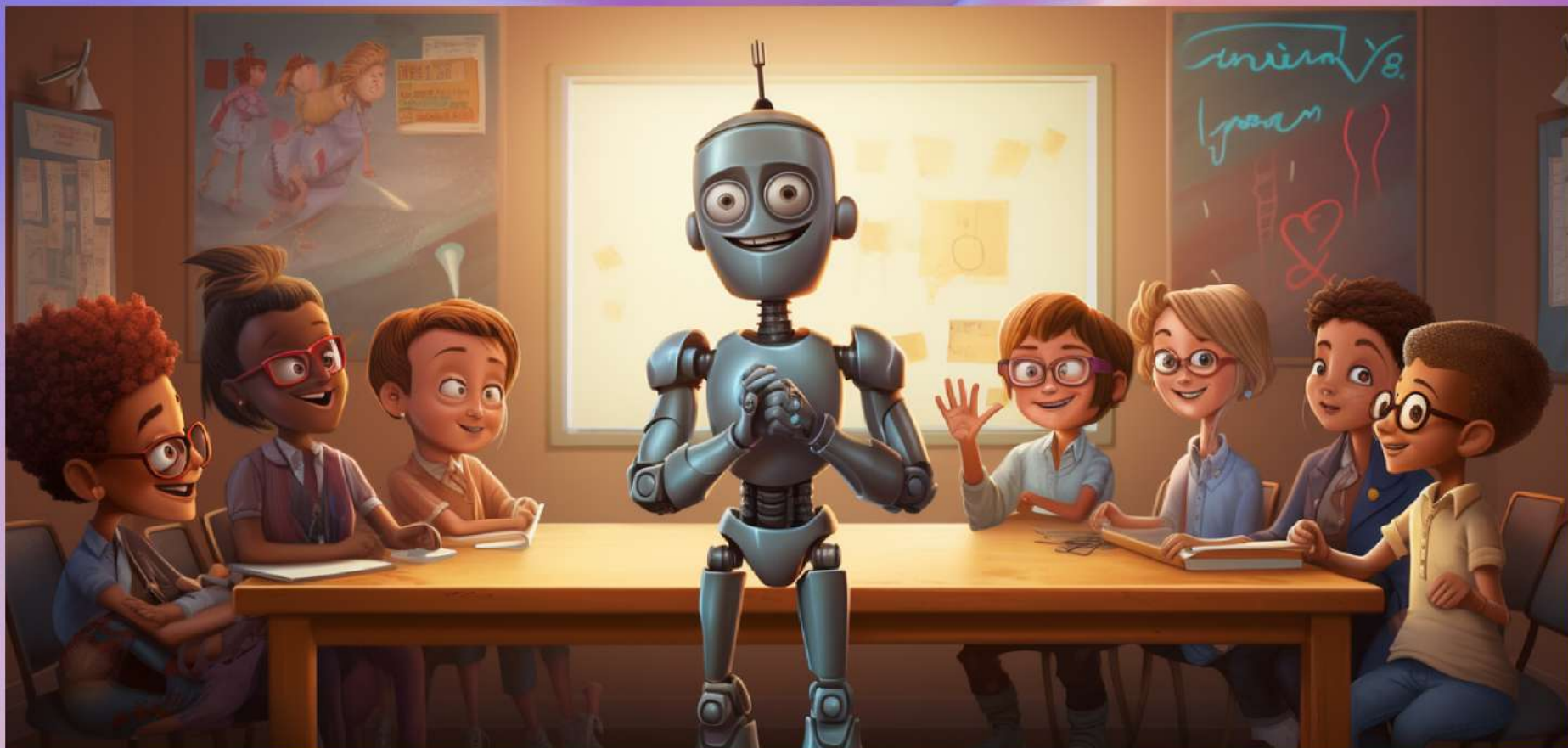
The lifeguard watched over them, making sure everyone was safe. He sat on his high chair, wearing sunglasses and a red whistle around his neck.
