City - Vocabulary



skyscraper: a very tall building (noun)



Shanghai has many **skyscrapers** in the city center.

City - Vocabulary



museum: a building where people can go to see cool things (noun)



The children were excited to go to the **museum** and see dinosaurs.

City - Vocabulary



sidewalk: a place for people to walk on, often at the side of a street or road (noun)



They walked on the **sidewalk** to stay safe.

City - Vocabulary



crosswalk: a painted area of a road or street where people can cross safely (noun)



The people used the **crosswalk** to cross the street.




