# City - Vocabulary



**mall:** a very large building that has many stores and often restaurants (noun)

# City - Vocabulary



**food court:** an area in the mall with many places to buy food with tables to sit and eat (noun)



We got hungry while shopping at the mall, so we ate lunch at the **food court**.

# City - Vocabulary



**elevator:** a machine that carries people up and down a building; a lift (noun)



She took the **elevator** to the eighteenth floor.

**cinema:** a place where people pay to watch films (movies); a movie theater (noun)



They ate popcorn while watching a movie at the **cinema**.

feel - felt  
leave - left


