# City - Vocabulary



**neighborhood:** a group of houses and buildings that are close together in a city or town (noun)



My **neighborhood** has many stores and houses.

# City - Vocabulary



**neighbor:** someone who lives near you in the same neighborhood (noun)



I like to chat with my **neighbor** when I see him outside.

# City - Vocabulary



**block (city block):** the smallest part of a city with streets all the way around it (noun)



I like to walk around the **block** for exercise.

**downtown:** the busiest part of a city with many buildings, shops, and people (noun)



The **downtown** area has many skyscrapers.

 get - got




