# Habitats - Vocabulary

**branch:** a part of a tree that grows out from the trunk (noun)



The bird sat on the tree **branch** looking around.

# Habitats - Vocabulary

**hang:** connect at the top and let the bottom move free in the air (verb)



The man was **hanging** off the cliff.

# Habitats - Vocabulary

**stick:** to stay in place and not move away easily (verb)



The paper **sticks** to his body.  
He used glue to **stick** the wood together.



# Habitats - Vocabulary

**sharp:** having a thin edge or point that can cut something or make a hole in something (adj)



One pencil is **sharp** but the other pencil is dull.
