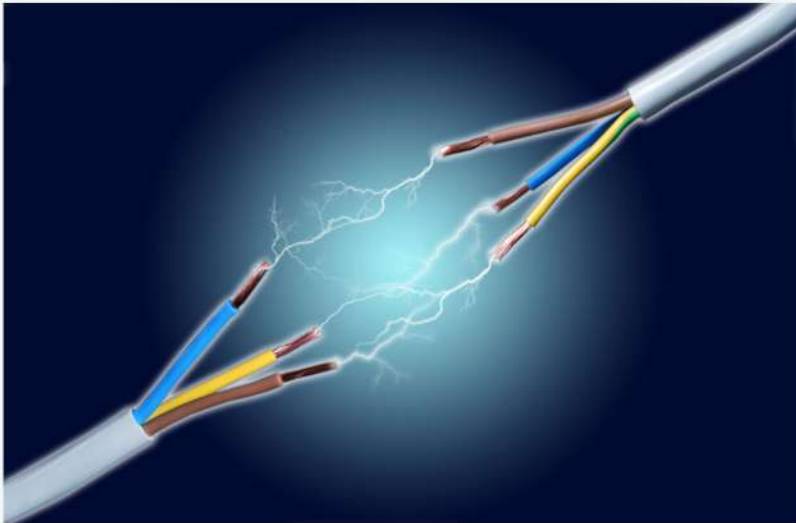

Jobs - Vocabulary

electricity: a type of energy that makes electrical things work (noun)



When you turn on the light, you are using **electricity**.

Jobs - Vocabulary

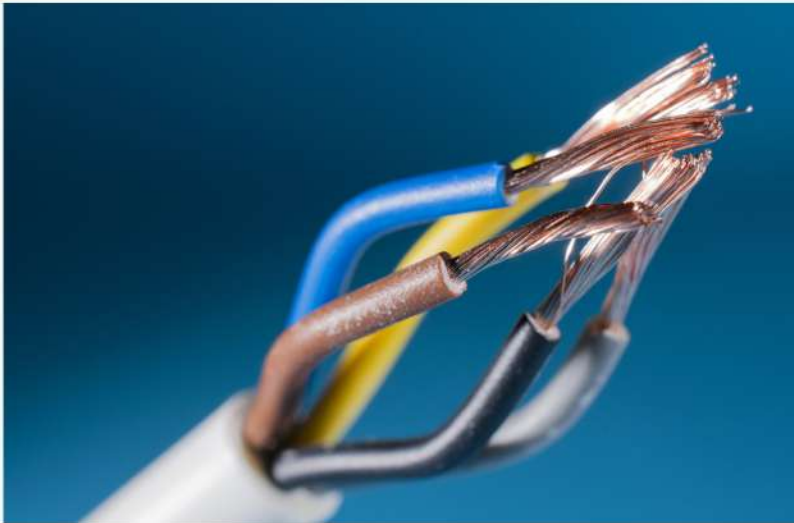
install: to put something new in a place so it can be used
(verb)



The plumber **installed** a new sink in the house.

Jobs - Vocabulary

wire: A long, thin piece of metal that carries electricity from one place to another (noun)



There were many **wires** at the top of the poles.

Jobs - Vocabulary

outlet: A place on the wall where you can plug in a cord to get electricity (noun)



You can charge your phone by plugging it into the **outlet**.

Fixing the Power

Jack is an electrician who helps people with electricity problems. One morning, he visits a house where the lights stop working. The customer feels worried because nothing turns on. Jack checks the wires carefully and finds a loose wire inside the wall. He turns off the power and fixes it safely. Soon, the lights work again. The customer smiles and thanks Jack for making the house bright and safe again.

Installing New Outlets

Later that day, Jack helps another customer who needs more outlets. The house has many computers and lamps, but not enough places to plug them in. Jack measures the wall and installs a new outlet near the desk. He connects each wire carefully and checks the electricity before finishing. When the outlet works, the customer feels happy. Now everyone can charge devices safely.
