VOCABULARY



Transport - Vocabulary

deliver: to take goods, letters, packages, etc., to people's houses or places of work (verb)



The store said they would **deliver** our new computer on Tuesday.

Transport - Vocabulary

cargo: the goods carried by a ship, aircraft, or other large vehicle (noun)



The delivery people loaded **cargo** into the van so they could deliver them.

Transport - Vocabulary

sort: to put a number of things in an order or to separate them into groups (verb)



They **sorted** the trash into different bins.

Transport - Vocabulary

traffic: the number of vehicles moving along roads, or the amount of aircraft, trains, or ships moving along a route (noun)



The **traffic** is really heavy, so we will probably be late for the party.
