# Hanging Out - Vocabulary

**hang out:** to spend a lot of time in a place or with someone for fun (phrasal verb)



I usually **hang out** with my friends on weekends.

# Hanging Out - Vocabulary

**permission:** the act of allowing someone to do something  
(noun)



I need to ask my teacher for **permission** to go to the bathroom.

# Hanging Out - Vocabulary

**browse:** to look at a lot of things in a shop, online, in a magazine, etc. (verb)



He is **browsing** the internet for places to go on vacation.

# Hanging Out - Vocabulary

**selfie:** a photo that you take of yourself, usually with a mobile phone (noun)



She took a **selfie** in front of the Eiffel Tower.






