# Markets - Vocabulary

**groceries:** items that you buy from a store for eating or using at home, like food or cleaning supplies (n)



My shopping basket was completely full of **groceries**.

# Markets - Vocabulary

**selection:** a variety of different things or options to choose from (noun)



This bookstore has a large **selection** of books to choose from.

# Markets - Vocabulary

**produce:** fresh fruits and vegetables that are grown on farms and sold in stores (n)



This supermarket has very fresh **produce** in its store.

# Markets - Vocabulary

**convenient:** something that is easy to use or suits your needs well, making life easier or more comfortable (adj)



Buying my coffee at a drive-thru is very **convenient**.

Answer

I **play** soccer on Saturdays.

Present Continuous

What **are** you **doing** today?

Answer

I **am playing** with my friends today.


Past Simple



